The Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP) is funded by the U.S. Department of Labor (DOL). Operation ABLE administers the SCSEP Program in Essex, Middlesex, Norfolk, Suffolk and Worcester counties in Massachusetts and in most of New Hampshire through a DOL national grant and a Massachusetts Executive Office of Elder Affairs state grant.

Operation ABLE is compliant with P.L. 116-94, Division A, Title V 505.

The Operation ABLE Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP) is funded by 90% of federal monies through the Department of Labor (DOL. The remaining 10% is funded by Operation ABLE and community match through non federal monies. The SCSEP National Grant award from DOL to Operation ABLE for Program Year 2020 (July 1, 2020 – June 30, 2020) is \$4,100,593.

For the current year Operation ABLE SCSEP funding is \$4,100,593. Operation ABLE and Community match is \$410,059
