Operation ABLE is a provider for the U.S. Department of Labor's Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP). We place qualified workers in subsidized positions at non-profit 501(c)(3) organizations and government agencies.

We match the skills, experience, and needs of participants with your staffing needs and your mission. The employer is required to help the participant learn new skills that can be used when the participant transitions out of the program into an unsubsidized position.

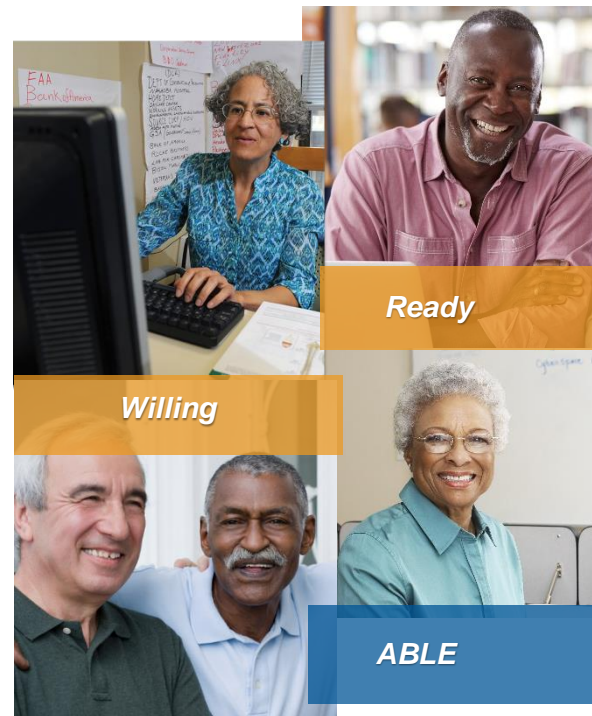

Participant Job Seeker Support and Training

SCSEP job seekers will be paid for training in their own community for up to 20 hours a week, gain new skills and work experience that lead to permanent employment.

Host Agency Responsibilities

We match the skills, experience, and needs of participant job seekers with your staffing needs and your mission. The employer is required to help the participant grow their skills and capabilities that can be used when the participant transitions out of the program into a permanent position.

Host Agency Benefits:

- Motivated employee for up to 20 hours per week.
- No cost to Employer Host Agency
- Non-Profit organizations and government agencies eligible for Host Agency status.
- SCSEP participant job seekers live within your community.

Advantages to Employers:

- Part-time staff member for up to 20 hours per week.
- Address staffing needs at no cost to your agency.
- Operation ABLE manages all payroll.
- Many of our job seeker participants are hired by the employer host agency as permanent employees.

How do I become a Host Agency?

Any 501(c)(3) or government agency can qualify as a host.

* The Senior Community Service Employment Program is a U.S. Department of Labor equal opportunity employer/program administered by Operation ABLE and the Executive Office of Elder Affairs. SCSEP Participants must meet Federal low-income guidelines. They will be paid for training in their own community for up to 20 hours a week, get help searching for a job, and gain new work experience, which can lead to unsubsidized employment.

* The Operation ABLE Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP) is funded with \$4,962,037 million through the Department of Labor (DOL). This funding provides 90% of the support for Operation ABLE's SCSEP program. The remaining 10%, \$551,337 thousand is funded by Operation ABLE and community match through non-federal monies. Operation ABLE's SCSEP program operates in Massachusetts and New Hampshire.
